Welcome to National Ballroom Dance Month! USA Dance Boise's mission is to promote and support ballroom dancing in our community. If you collect the most dance experiences this month, not only will you have broadened your ballroom horizons, but you will be recognized at USA Dance Boise's annual gala, Mad Hot for Ballroom and win some fancy dance prizes!

How to play: For each of the items below, complete the listed task. Record the date and location of completion, and have your dance instructor or dance partner initial beside the task for verification. Once you have completed the most tasks you can, return this sheet to a USA Dance Boise board member on or before October 4, 2014.

- **Rules:** All tasks must be completed and all signatures must be collected between August 30 and October 4th, 2014. Don't cheat – the point of the scavenger hunt is for people to have fun new dance experiences, get to know other dancers in the community, and see what our local dance teachers and scene have to offer. The prizes are good, but they aren't worth spoiling the spirit of the hunt over. You do not need to fill out the whole sheet (in fact, it should be very difficult to do so).
- **Dances:** Dance experiences can be in any of the 19 ballroom dance styles, club dances (Night Club 2-step, Hustle, etc.), country & western dancing (2-step), ancestors or cousins of ballroom dance (Lindy Hop, Argentine Tango, Salsa, etc.) or any partner dance that is led and followed.
- **Photos:** If you take photos, you must e-mail them to erinr@cableone.net before October 1st. You understand the photos may be used in USA Dance promotional materials (i.e. brochures, website)
- **Questions:** Call or text (208) 585-7320 or e-mail if you need clarification on anything during the hunt.
